SELECTION CRITERIA

- * Excellent academic standing
- * Demonstrated leadership ability
- * Community service, with an emphasis on non-school related volunteering
- * A personal interview with a panel of Rotarians
(This interview places an emphasis on Rotary and acknowledges the privilege you are offering this student in representing your club in the program).
- * You can select a non-Canadian exchange student but due to the emphasis of the program in citizenship values, the preference is for Canadian citizen or landed immigrant between the ages of 16 and 18.

(Students must be 16 before May 24, 2025).
- * We also ask that Rotary clubs consider the diversity of the country when selecting their student representative and perhaps look for a student who is Indigenous or from an ethnic minority.
