This scholarship aims to honour students that exemplify Herb's passion for giving and helping through community service and continuous efforts to help others.

Eligibility

A recipient must:

- be a Canadian Citizen, a Permanent Resident, or Protected Person (visa students are not eligible)
- be a BC resident, for which 1 of the following conditions must apply:

- 1 parent, or legal guardian has maintained permanent residence in Canada for at least 12 consecutive months immediately prior to commencing secondary studies and be residing in BC, or
- BC is the last place the student has lived 12 consecutive months immediately prior to commencing secondary studies.
- be graduating from Revelstoke High School in the current academic year.

Criteria

- exemplify the spirit of community service in Revelstoke.
- demonstrate exemplary initiative, leadership, and creativity in their service to others.
- serve as a role model for others in their community.
- inspire others to engage in volunteer service.
- improve the overall quality of life of fellow citizens of BC and the community as a whole.

Application Essay

Applicants for the Herb Shaede Scholarship are required to submit an essay of up to 1,000 words addressing the following questions:

1. How have you demonstrated commitment, enthusiasm, and initiative as a volunteer in the Revelstoke Community.
2. How has volunteering in Revelstoke made a difference in your life?
3. How has volunteering improved the life of those your volunteer efforts support?
4. How will you continue to volunteer to improve the quality of life of the community at large?

Supporting Documents In addition to the applicant information and application essay, applicants must submit the following documents:

1. A resumé.

2. Up to three reference letters, with comments on your character and leadership skills from community members, such as but not limited to a: teacher, school admin or counsellor, coach, employer, or volunteer supervisor.
3. Please note that references from relatives will not be considered.
