The Trade Sampler program is designed for students in Grades 11 and 12 who are strongly considering a career in the trades. Throughout the year, students will explore a variety of trades, including Automotive, Electrical, Welding, and Carpentry. The program operates as a full shop experience and is offered in either Semester 1 or Semester 2.

A high level of commitment and dedication is required; unexcused absences may result in removal from the program. Students must complete an application to be considered for registration.

The program includes three Trade Sampler courses and one Auto Drive Train course. It is also highly recommended that students include a Work Experience (WEX) course, which may provide opportunities toward a future apprenticeship. Upon successful completion of all components, students can earn up to 20 credits.
