### RSS Track and Field Team

RSS Track wrapped up the year with a successful trip to the provincials in Langley on June 4-6th. Jacqueline Cottingham led the way with two top 8 finishes - 7th in the high jump and 8th in the 400m. In addition there were other students who finished in the top 8 of the province: Jacob Ancell -- 6th in shot-put and Aleks Klassen -- 7th in Javelin. This year, the provincials were streamed live over the internet and many in Revelstoke were able to watch the track events unfold in real-time, a great way to experience the team's success. Another highlight for the track team this year was having Olympic Bronze Medalist Dylan Armstrong come to Revelstoke and work with our track athletes. With almost 60 athletes on the track team this year, RSS once again showed that they are the most dominant track team in the Okanagan Zone.
