

Grade 12 Scholarship Program Guidelines

Regular scholarship requirements:

- Must be currently enrolled in the final year of studies at a public secondary school in British Columbia
- Expected to graduate in June
- Good academic achievement - official school transcript of grades (to date) must be provided)
- Demonstrated exemplary service and leadership within the school and community (please provide 2 examples of service and 2 of leadership)
- 2 letters of reference affirming how the applicant has improved the quality of life for young people/others through volunteer work and/or other activities
- The application must be accompanied by a short, no more than one-page description of how volunteer service has made a difference in the life or lives of others
- Proof of application/entry to post-secondary
- A completed application form
- Applications deadline: **February 9, 2018**

BCSSA Process for selection

- One finalist will be chosen from each of the six BCSSA provincial chapters by the Membership Chair in each chapter or a designate
- Each finalist will be awarded a \$1000 scholarship
- Once proof of registration has been provided a cheque will be issued to the successful applicants
- Successful applicants will need to provide their Social Insurance Number for BCSSA audit purposes
