MyEd BC: Course Selections

For Students

Course Selections happen using the MyEd BC Portal and it can be accessed by students and their parents/guardians. Here is a guide to show you navigation elements and help you through this process:

- 1 Navigate to the 'My Info' tab or click on the student name. You are looking for the 'Request' option on the sidebar.
- 2 Read the 'Instructions' section carefully to ensure you know your requirements and options for next year.
- 3 To check the status of your BC Assessments or your current credits, you can use the 'Transcript' button in the sidebar. (Highlighted)
- 4 The 'Primary Requests' section allows you to select courses and read course descriptions for different subject areas. Click the courses you want to add and refer back to the 'Instructions' to ensure you have the right number of courses.
- 5 To conclude your session, hit the Post button and log out.
